CAST A "NET"

Natural Environment Teaching or NET, is a system which allows the learner to be taught in a natural environment that can mimic a familiar setting for the individual. Using NET, we create daily routines, providing numerous opportunities to teach socially significant behaviors. These can include communication, social skills, daily living goals, and many more. NET is an evidence-based practice used by practitioner of ABA and can be used in a clinical setting.



BEHAVIORAL FUN WITH DTT

DTT refers to a Discrete Trial Training that is highly structured and is typically conducted in a contrived setting at a table. This is where skills are broken down into smaller steps and components are taught one by one.

SOCIAL SKILLS

Our Social Skills Training uses a variety of interventions to improve social interactions. We target a variety of skills that are fundamental to developing social behaviors. Our SST can include interacting with peers, perspective taking, expressing emotions, recognizing social cues, and appropriate responding.
